Quick pointers


Make sure the surface is flat to ensure the strongest hold. If you've just painted, allow 2 weeks for paint to fully dry/cure before installation.

The adhesive is **VERY STRONG**, so you'll need to be extra sure the area is fully wiped and ready before installation.




LEVEL 1 INSTALLATION

INSIDE MOUNT


Peel off the adhesive from the back of the shade's headrail. Make sure to not get anything stuck to it before you place it on the wall. Only peel the adhesive when you're ready to install.


Slide the shade into the opening and press the shade's headrail firmly up on the top of the window opening for about 30 seconds. Allow the shade 24 hours for the adhesive to fully set.

OUTSIDE MOUNT

Using a pencil, make a straight line at least 11/8" above the window opening. If you want to ensure the product will hang and operate evenly, use a Level to make sure the line is straight.



Peel off the adhesive from the back of the shade's headrail. Make sure to not get anything stuck to it before you place it on the wall. Only peel the adhesive when you're ready to install.

Turn the shade around and line the top of the headrail up with the mark on the wall. Press the shade's headrail firmly for about 30 seconds. Lower the shade down and allow the shade 24 hours for the adhesive to fully set.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

For regular maintenance, use a duster or a vacuum with a brush attachment and run it over the front and back of the shade.

To spot clean stains, use a damp rag with a very mild, gentle detergent or soap. Dab at the affected spots; DO NOT RUB! Let the dampened area air dry and repeat as necessary.

All fabrics are different and some may be easier to clean than others. We recommend cleaning your shades as often as once a month.
