INSTALLING THE CHILD SAFFTY TENSION DEVICE

- Dangling or accessible cords on window coverings can pose an accidental strangulation hazard to infants and young children. It is required that the child safety tension device be installed to remove slack from cords. Install tension device on the window frame to remove all slack on the drawstring cord.
- · (see Fig 2) attach to wall/widow frame via screw
- (see Fig 1) not attached to the window frame, locks drawstring from continual use.

ADJUSTING COUNTER BALANCE WEIGHTS

To prevent uneven raising (Telescoping) of your Zebra Shade you can adjust the counter balance weights on the bottom side of the bottom rail.

Select Dual Shade Bottom Rail



To adjust weight, gently unscrew each screw on the ends of each weight. Slide the weight left or right to the desired position, taking care to equally space the weights from the ends. Test by raising the shade and look for an even raise. If shade raises slightly tilted to one side adjust the appropriate weight to the desired position and test the shade again. Once shade is balanced screw weight locks back down.

(only if you have ordered hold down brackets)

- · Lower the shade to the desired height.
- Position the hold down bracket to align the tab.
- Mount the bracket using the two screws provided (see Fig 1). Insert the tab into pre-drilled hole. To raise or lower the shade, release the bottom rail from the brackets by pulling the brackets away from the bottom rail.

WFI COME TO YOUR E-SERIES WINDOW COVERING

E-SERIES MOTOR NOTE:

The E-SERIES Motor can be found in the headrail of your E-Series Window Covering. Ensure that all connections are connected prior to installation, this will prevent future need to remove the Window Covering from the installed location.



WAKE YOUR E-SERIES WINDOW COVERING Press, STOP/TILT for 2 seconds to wake your Window Covering.


SETTING KEY BUTTON NOTE:

The Setting Key Button can be found on the Motor inside the headrail of your E-Series Window Covering and at the back of the Motorized Wand (reference figure 1). A paper clip or rounded pointy object can be used to troubleshoot the function of the Window Covering.


If your Motorized Wand is attached, there is a small pinhole Setting Key Button on the back just above the Micro USB port. Use this in-place of the Setting Key Button in the headrail, as this may be difficult to reach.

The Setting Key Button needs to be released at the final specified jog to allow for the Window Covering to beep in understanding of the configuration requested.

Jog: 1 small movement from the motor indicating the device is configuring

MOTORIZED DUAL SHADE PROGRAMMING INSTRUCTIONS

NOTICE: ALL SHADES COME PRE-PROGRAMMED FROM THE FACTORY. THIS GUIDE SERVES AS A TROUBLESHOOTING AID. IF THE CONSUMER RESETS THE PROGRAMMING, TECHNICAL SUPPORT WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE MANUFACTURER.

Setting Lift Heights

(This section is for setting the lift heights after the shade has undergone a full system reset. For instructions adjusting an already set lift height see the next section.)

For Top:

Press and hold the up button for two seconds and the shade will begin to rise. A single push
of the button in this mode will only jog the shade up a few inches. When the shade reaches
your desired top height press the middle stop button. Press and hold the stop and up buttons
at the same time looking for the shad to jog twice and beep once confirming the top height
being set.

For Bottom:

Press and hold the down button for two seconds and the shade will begin to lower. A single
push of the button in this mode will only jog the shade down a few inches. When the shade
reaches your desired bottom height press the middle stop button. Press and hold the
stop and down buttons at the same time looking for the shad to jog twice and beep once
confirming the bottom height being set.

Adjusting Lift Heights

(This section is to adjust lift heights of an already programmed shade.)

For Up:

Press and hold the stop and up buttons for 10 seconds looking for a single jog. The shade is
now temporarily in adjustment mode and single pushes of the up or down will raise and lower
the shade in small increments. Press and hold the up button for two seconds and the shade
will begin to raise. Press the stop button at the desired height. Press and hold the stop and up
buttons for two seconds looking for two jogs and one beep. The new top height is set.

For Bottom:

• Press and hold the stop and down buttons for 10 seconds looking for a single jog. The shade is now temporarily in adjustment mode and single pushes of the up or down will raise and lower the shade in small increments. Press and hold the down button for two seconds and the shade will begin to raise. Press the stop button at the desired height. Press and hold the stop and down buttons for two seconds looking for two jogs and one beep. The new bottom height is set.

(If heights are not set within one minute of initialization the system will timeout and the motor will default back to the last used top and bottom heights)

Switching Between Jog and Full Motion Modes

Jog Mode allows for the shade to lower or raise in small increments with a single push of the appropriate button. A three second push in Jog Mode will raise or lower completely. Full Motion Mode will raise or lower the shade completely with a single button push.

To change between modes press and hold the up and down buttons on the wand for 3 seconds waiting for one jog and three beeps confirming the change.

Changing Lift Directions

Press and hold the wand reset button for 6 seconds waiting for two separate single jogs. Release immediately after the second jog listening for two beeps. The lifting directions have now been reversed. Sheer opening is not available in this configuration. Shade can open and close but cannot tilt.

Full System Reset

(This section is for completely resetting the shade. This should only be done as a last resort when all other solutions have failed.)

To fully reset all settings on the shade press and hold the reset button on either the motor or wand for 15 seconds looking for three separate sets of jogs followed by three beeps. All settings have now been reset on the shade. Follow the following steps below with the instructions above to re-initialize your shades.

Initializing Your Shade:

- Reverse Shade Direction (Only if reset occurred on the motor. If the reset occurred on the control wand disregard)
- 2. Set Top Height
- 3. Set Bottom Height
- 4. Switch from Jog Mode to Full Motion Mode if desired
- 5. Enjoy Your Shade
